WHAT GOES IN A STORYBOARD:

WHAT DOESN'T GO IN A STORYBOARD:

Learning objectives linked to each screen or module	Tangential content unrelated to objectives
On-screen text and narration scripts	Placeholder text (e.g., "Insert content here")
Visual and media descriptions (e.g., images, animations, video)	Overly detailed design notes about fonts, colors, or layout
Interaction types and learner actions (e.g., clicks, drag/drop)	Vague directions like "make this more engaging."
Assessment questions and feedback logic	Quiz questions that haven't been validated or linked to learning objectives
Navigation instructions and branching logic	Redundant or confusing navigation options
Notes for developers and voiceover artists	Internal SME debates or unresolved content arguments
Accessibility considerations (e.g., alt text, keyboard access)	Design decisions that exclude learners with accessibility needs
